**THE TROUBLE WITH YOU** (En liberté!) France 2018 (Comedy, Crime, Drama) 108min (M)

**Director: Pierre Salvadori** **Cast: Adèle Haenel, Pio Marmai, Vincent Elbaz, Damien Bonnard, Audrey Tautou**

Set on the French Riviera, the wonderful Adèle Haenel (The Unknown Girl, BPM) plays detective Yvonne, the principled young widow of the local police chief who was killed in the line of duty. Each night she puts their young son to sleep with tales of his daring and bravery, so naturally Yvonne is horrified to learn that her husband was not the embodiment of virtue as she had been led to believe.

**NON-FICTION** (Doubles vies) France 2018 (Comedy, Drama, Romance) 108min (M)

Set in the Parisian publishing world, an editor and an author find themselves in over their heads, as they cope with a middle-age crisis, the changing industry and their wives. Featuring humorous intellectual conversations that touch on everything from the importance of Twitter in modern discourse to our tendencies to vote for politicians based on image over policy.

**GIRL** Belgium, Netherlands, France 2018 (Drama) 109min (M)

Lara is an adolescent transgender girl from Belgium. Her struggle is not so much with her gender identity as with her passion to become a professional ballerina. Supported by her Francophone father and younger brother, she commences her journey into gender reassignment, yet her teenage impatience and the immense pressures of ballet push Lara to the brink.

**ASTERIX AND THE MAGIC POTION** (Astérix: Le secret de la potion magique) France 2018 (Drama) 85min (PG)

While collecting ingredients for the secret magic potion that has helped our beloved Gaulish village hold out against Julius Cesar and his invading army so valiantly, the venerable druid Getafix suffers a terrible accident. As he recovers from his injuries, he realises a succession plan must be put in place to pass on his magic potion and keep the village safe.

**THE IDEAL PALACE** (L'incroyable histoire du facteur Cheval) France 2018 (Biography) 105min (CTC)

Set in 1879, Cheval is a humble postman. He leads an unassuming life, seemingly revelling in the solitude of his 20-mile delivery routes and daydreaming about the world of wonders that he only sees through the postcards and magazines he delivers. He meets and falls in love with the breathtaking Philomène and the arrival of their baby daughter, Alice, causes him to look at things in a different way. He sets about building a castle for Alice – one fit for a princess – that consumes the next 30-plus years of his life.

**WHO YOU THINK I AM** (Celle que vous croyez) France 2019 (Comedy, Drama) 101min (MA15+)

Claire, is a 50-year-old divorced teacher, a mother of two teenage boys, who is contending with the approach of middle age and remains stung by the betrayal of her ex-husband. She creates a fake Facebook profile of a 24-year-old woman. She finds a photo of a pretty young brunette and uses it. She has created an entirely fictional character, but why?

**SINK OR SWIM** (Le Grand Bain) France 2018 (Comedy, Drama, Sport) 122min (M)

**Director: Gilles Lellouche** **Cast: Guillaume Canet, Mathieu Amalric, Jean-Hugues Anglade, Benoît Poelvoorde**

A disparate group of 40-somethings – all in the throes of mid-life crises – form a local swimming pool's inaugural, males-only synchronised swimming team. Staring down ongoing ridicule and contempt from all angles, they engage a fallen champion, Delphine as their coach, supported by her tough-as-nails former swim partner, Amanda.
