Teaching

Our teachers also form a vital part of our Committee and our Alliance as a whole, and to Verity, Marine, Morgane and Juliette (as well as to Cécile of course!) I extend my gratitude for the excellence of your teaching which is at the heart of the raison d'être of AFSC. You put your heart and soul into their teaching. In fact, while I am talking to you, Verity and Marine are receiving training to obtain their status of correctors for DELF/DALF exams as did Cécile in September 2025 and Morgane in January 2025. This proves the dedication of our teachers taking their precious free time to enhance their skills for the benefit of our students and our AF.

The turn-over generated from classes reflects our teachers' great work: \$143,000 as at 30th June 2025 compared to \$117,000 as the same date in 2024, which represents an increase of 22,2% in one year! The online classes continue also to be very much in demand.

The first sessions of Yoga in French led by Marie-Hélène in November at the Nambour Yoga Centre have been very successful and we shall resume this initiative in Term 2, 2026.

Memberships.

Every organisation is only as strong as its members and I am thrilled to say that our Membership remains strong just over the 300 mark. Our members enjoy our cultural and social events as well as our classes and it is important that they know that we will never take your continued membership for granted. We also rely on our members' feedback to continuously improve our services as per the Démarche-Qualité we follow.

Cultural and Social Activities.

The Sunshine Coast French Film Festival continues to give us a great visibility thanks to Murray's superb selection of films were shown in Caloundra, Nambour, Noosa and Maroochydore.

Our Café Conversations are cultural rendez-vous enjoyed in 3 locations on the Sunshine Coast (Twin Waters of course thanks to the amazing partnership we have with the Loose Goose, but also in Golden Beach and Peregian Springs). By varying the venues, we try to make it as easy as possible for all our members, no matter where they live, to find a convenient place to join us for a regular dose of French language and culture.

In addition to Café Conversations, the Club Déjeuner led by Caroline and her amazing team of volunteers once a month, mid-week Lunch at different restaurants across the region are proving exceptionally popular with you all and fit perfectly with the spirit of community « partage ».

The newly launched Club Pétanque is another example of Volunteers putting their head together to bring a unique experience of fun and camaraderie on the Sunshine Coast. Watch this space with Caroline and her faithful volunteers at the helm!

These events will continue in 2026, so make sure you keep checking our website as well as the newsletters which Cécile regularly sends to us all so that you will be the first to hear what is happening. Our focus next year will be on Volunteer Management and Charity work as new initiatives are taking shape thanks to funding received from the Department of Social Services as well as from the French Embassy.
